

# Kraft Bloomin Beautiful Card

## SUPPLIES

**Stamps:** Bloomin Beautiful, Sanded

**Inks:** Basic Gray, Sahara Sand, Close to Cocoa, Almost Amethyst, Bashful Blue Classic Inks and Summer Sun Stampin' Write Marker

**Papers:** Kraft, Whisper White and Bashful Blue

**Other:** Blender Pen, Spiral Punch, Hemp Twine and sponge

## CUTTING & PUNCHING

### Kraft

8.5" x 5.5", score at 4.25"  
the top

### Bashful Blue

3.5" x 4.25"

### Whisper White

3" x 4", spiral punch

## STAMPING

1. Stamp the vase of flowers using Basic Gray Ink onto the 3" x 4" piece of Whisper White Cardstock
2. Using a Blender Pen, first color all the flowers using Almost Amethyst Ink and the Squeeze Technique
3. Add dimension to the flowers by coloring over the shaded areas (little shading lines) using the Blender Pen and Bashful Blue Ink with the Squeeze Technique
4. Color the leaves in the same fashion as the flowers using Certainly Celery Ink and then shading with Mellow Moss Ink
5. Do the same for the flower pot using Close to Cocoa Ink.  
**\*\*\*Hint:** To give the flower pot a realistic look be sure to leave a bit of white space in the center.
6. Ink the Sanded Background Stamp with Sahara Sand Ink and stamp over the bottom half of the flower/pot image.
7. For both the Whisper White and Bashful Blue Cardstocks tear the bottom edges, distress the all the edges of the cardstock using scissors or a distressing tool and sponging on Sahara Sand Ink
8. Adhere the Whisper White Cardstock to the Bashful Blue Cardstock, wrap Hemp Twine around the top and fray the edges using a needle tool or scissors.
9. Stamp the blossom definition onto the card front at the bottom right and top left using Sahara Sand Ink
